SECTION - 3

DETAILS OF EXPRESSION OF INTEREST (EoI)

3.1. ABOUT MDL

Mazagon Dock Shipbuilders Limited (MDL) is a leading submarine and shipbuilding company in the country with a Miniratna Category-1. The company was taken over by the Government of India and established as a Public Sector Undertaking under the Ministry of Defence in 1960. Over the last six decades, MDL has delivered over 250 warships/submarines/ platforms to various customers in India and abroad. Out of these 30 major warships/submarines have been delivered to the Indian Navy. The diversified platforms delivered to various customers range from Destroyers, Stealth Frigates, Submarines, Missile Boats, Corvettes, Offshore Patrol Vessels, Multipurpose Support Vessels, Offshore Supply Vessels, Dredgers, Tugs and Cargo-Cum-Passenger Vessels.

3.2. Purpose of this EOI

MDL is looking for collaboration with Firms / Institute having experience of Design of Deep Ocean Simulator. If more than one eligible firms is submitting response to this EOI, further shortlisting shall be done through separate selection process to collaborate and bid for the requirement of Deep Ocean Simulator.

3.3. Proposed Technical Requirement of Deep Ocean Simulator

3.3.1. AIM

To collaborate with Firm for Design and Development of Deep Ocean Simulator.

3.3.2. The Scope of work for collaboration and specification of the required Deep Ocean Simulator is as follows:

A) Scope

Collaborating firm / institute to Design Deep Ocean Simulator and Oversee the Fabrication, Assembly, test and trial in India. System Fabrication and Assembly shall be done at MDL. Final Installation shall be done at identified client's location.

B) Specification

Deep Ocean Simulator 1

Internal Diameter 2.8 m \times 3.0 m height (for Vertical installation) or Internal Diameter 3.0 m \times 3.5 m length (for Horizontal installation) of 1200 bar internal pressure, quantity 1 number.

Deep Ocean Simulator 2

Internal Diameter 1.0 m x 1.5 m height (for Vertical installation) of 1500 bar internal pressure, quantity 1 number.

Note: Both systems capable of providing internal water temperature of 1 to 5 °C, in an ambient temperature up to 40 °C at the site of installation and both systems may have common system like cooling unit, pneumatic line and water reservoir.

C) Training to be provided

- i. Operation and maintenance of DOS, including trouble shooting.
- ii. Electrical/Controls/hydraulic system.
- iii. Safety and Emergency system.
- iv. Safety of equipment/human during pressure testing and qualification.
- v. Repair/Servicing.

D) Documents to be provided

The bidder/supplier/manufacture should provide two set of documents in soft and hard copy along with the supply and not limited to the list below for both systems.

- i. Design document bringing out the details and material specification of the chamber, lids, attachments, actuators, sensors and seals.
- ii. Design calculation and Finite Element Analysis (FEA) report
- iii. Calculation of fatigue life prediction of facility.
- iv. Comprehensive drawings of all parts and assembly drawing (2D and 3D) that are supplied.
- v. Facility layout drawing, hydraulic circuit drawing, pneumatic circuit drawing, pressure line drawing, electric circuit drawing & control circuit drawing.
- vi. Stress-strain measurement values at critical points during pressure testing (working, design, design pressure and test pressure as per standard).
- vii. Test & Certificate Reports (material chemical and mechanical properties, forging heat number, heat treatment, NDT (X-ray/Ultrasound), manufacturing/fabrication process).
- viii. Third party inspection reports.
- ix. Operations manual including alarms and trouble-shooting.
- x. Maintenance & repair manual.
- xi. Bill of materials and spare parts catalogue.
- xii. Controller software copy.
- **E) Delivery Period:** To be delivered and commissioned at client's location within 18 months from the date of signing of the contract.
- **F)** Warranty: The Deep Ocean Simulator (DOS) should be having a warranty for 12 months from the date of commissioning and acceptance by client.
- G) Spare parts

- Recommended maintenance tools and spares/repair kit as required for the DOS system to be supplied, for at least three (03) years of trouble-free operation.
- ii. The required items to be assessed and provided by the bidder.
- **iii.** The list of items to be supplied as spares shall be provided along with technical bid.

3.4. INSTRUCTIONS

- **3.4.1.** Language: All correspondences and documents related to the EoI response shall be in English language only.
- **3.4.2.** The participating firm shall abide by the terms & conditions, as applicable, of the EoI.
- **3.4.3.** All pages of the EoI shall be duly signed by the authorised signatory.
- **3.4.4.** Multiple proposals from the same participating firm should not be submitted.
- **3.4.5.** MDL at their discretion shall inspect the participating firm works/office/reference site premises for the purpose of evaluation, as deemed necessary before selection of partner. MDL decision in this regard shall be final.
- **3.4.6.** Any participating firm which has been debarred/blacklisted by Central/State Governments or by any entity controlled by Central/State Governments from participating in any of their project, as on date of submission of EoI, shall not be eligible to submit the EoI.

3.5. PROCESS TO BE CONFIDENTIAL:

Information relating to the examination, clarification, evaluation and comparison of EoI and recommendations shall not be disclosed to participating firm. Any effort by participating firm to influence MDL processing of EoI or selection decisions may result in the rejection of the EoI.

3.6. MISCELLANEOUS:

3.6.1. Right to accept or reject any or all Applications:

- i. Notwithstanding anything contained in this EoI, MDL reserves the right to accept or reject any application and to annul the EoI process and reject all applications, at any time without any liability or any obligation for such acceptance, rejection or annulment and without assigning any reasons, thereof. In the event that MDL rejects or annuls all the applications, it may at its discretion, invite all eligible participating firms to submit fresh applications.
- ii. MDL reserves the right to disqualify any applicant during or after completion of EoI process, if it is found there was a material misrepresentation by any such applicant or the applicant fails to provide within the specified time, supplemental information sought by MDL.
- iii. MDL reserves the right to verify all statements, information and documents submitted by the applicant in response to the EoI. Any such verification or lack of such verification by MDL shall not relieve the applicant of his obligations or liabilities hereunder nor will it affect any rights of MDL.

3.6.2. Governing Laws & Jurisdiction:

The EoI process shall be governed by, and construed in accordance with, the laws of India and the Courts at Mumbai (India) shall have exclusive jurisdiction over all disputes arising under, pursuant to and / or in connection with the EoI process.

SECTION-4

PRE-QUALIFICATION CRITERIA

The determination of eligibility will take into account the technical and experience capabilities and past performance of the participating firm; it will be based upon an examination of documentary evidence of the participating firm qualifications submitted by the participating firm as well as such other information, as the MDL deems necessary and appropriate. The participating firm willing to associate with MDL should meet the following Pre-Qualification Criteria:

4.1. Technical Qualification: -

- i. Pre-qualification: Institution/Bidder/supplier/manufacturer/consortium of Firms should have experience of having designed/manufactured/integrated and/or supplied similar Hyperbaric Test Facility/Deep Ocean Simulator of minimum inner diameter 1.5 m and inner length of 3.0 m and a minimum operating pressure of 900 bar, at least once over the last 15 years. Proof of execution/supply and attested copies of work completion /testimonials for past clients etc., need to be enclosed. Actual photographs and technical details of deep ocean simulator project executed to be attached.
- ii. Organization Profile.
- iii. Details and personnel (Project Management Team) with designation, qualification and experience to determine their capabilities.
- iv. List of Projects executed other than deep ocean simulator exhibiting the capability of the organization.
- v. Undertaking from firm that
 - a) The bidder shall be willing to sign Consortium / Agreement / MOU / JV with MDL to work in collaboration for executing future projects as per client's requirements.
 - b) Designer / OEM should be willing to support for indigenisation of equipment/parts of Deep Ocean Simulator.
- 4.2. **Commercial Qualification:** The bidder shall submit the following as a part of commercial qualification.
 - i. Undertaking from firm that they are not be under a declaration of ineligibility /blacklisting issued by Govt. of India / State govt. / Public Sector Undertakings etc.
 - ii. Indian Bidder:
 - a. Shop & Establishment registration certificate.
 - b. Certificate of Incorporation / Partnership deed as applicable.

- c. Registration certificate from local bodies for conducting business.
- d. MSME, Startup certificate
- e. GST certificate
- iii. **Foreign Bidder:** Registration certificates for conducting business as relevant issued by respective Govt.

In case of Indian Representative, foreign firm to submit authorization letter signed by both the parties.

4.3. Financial Qualification: -

- i. Shall have Avg Annual turnover of Rs. 1 cr (min) or equivalent Foreign currency during the last three years ending as on 31 Mar 2020 to participate in this EOI.
- ii. The Bidder shall enclose with its Proposal as per **Annexure-1**, certificate issued by Chartered Accountant with their seal and signature, stating the firms net worth & turnover during the past three years. Firm to submit financial documents for last 3 years.

SECTION-5

<u>Bid Rejection Criteria</u>: - MDL may at its sole discretion and at any time during the evaluation of proposal, disqualify any bidder, if they have:

- a) Bids received after due date.
- b) Bidder's failure to furnish sufficient or complete details for evaluation of the bids within the given period.
- c) Incomplete / misleading / false / ambiguous in the proof of eligibility requirements.
- d) Failed to produce timely clarifications related thereto, when sought.
- e) Bids not meeting qualification criteria mentioned above.
- f) Submitted more than one proposal for single specialisation area.
- g) Declared ineligible by the Government of India / State govt. / Public sector undertaking.
- h) Bids with technical requirements and or terms not acceptable to MDL.
